Footnotes

TRUELYONBROADWAY tracked the pace, raced three wide around the turn, then rallied outside the drifting BAD DEBT to be just up at the wire. BAD DEBT rank in the early going while chasing the pace, rallied to take over at the quarter pole, opened a clear lead in midstretch, then drifted out late and just failed to last. LABERINTO (URU) unhurried early, angled out in the stretch and closed well for the show. NATHAN RIDGE tracked the pace off the rail into the stretch and weakened. BE WELCOME set the pace along the inside to nearing the quarter pole, then gave way. TORCELLO stumbled at the start, then steadied from close quarters in the chute, rushed up along the rail to track the leaders into the stretch, then tired. DANCE FLOOR MANIAC tracked the pace into the turn and faltered. UNBRIDLED FUTURE was no factor after being checked from between rivals at the start. CANCERBERO raced three wide and faded.
