MARKET PRINCESS raced close up inside, waited patiently on the turn, rallied on the rail, split rivals late and drew clear in hand. MUSICALDEFINITION vied outside early, cleared off to set the pace, responded in upper stretch and was no match for the winner. MICHAEL'S ABBY stalked three wide, bid on the far turn and stayed on to best the others. DODIE JO vied early, then tracked inside and raced evenly through the stretch. DELTA LADY raced three wide

early, then saved ground and lacked a rally. STARSHIP PLEASANT raced between foes, came three wide into the lane and had no rally. BRIDAL COURT raced off the pace, came wide and failed to rally. ENGLISH BEAUTY raced off the pace, five wide past the quarter pole and failed to menace. LADY MYRKA had a three wide trip and weakened. CASCINA raced three wide, four wide on the backside and did not factor. SAM'S SUNNY CITY was eased in the stretch. DANIELA'S FLOWER raced four wide early, bolted on the far turn and was pulled up.
