Footnotes

CALL AN AUDIBLE unhurried early, advanced into contention off the rail, was bothered by CATALITA nearing the eighth pole, then rallied under pressure to be up late. CATALITA stalked the pace, was forced out a bit by DANCING DEE at the eighth pole, moved to gain a slim lead in deep stretch but couldn't hold off the winner in the closing yards. ELTISHA up close racing along the rail, slipped through inside DANCING DEE to reach near even terms for command inside the eighth pole, then weakened. DANCING DEE set the pace along the inside, drifted out a bit at the eighth pole forcing CATALITA out, then gave way. MOONLET MINISTER unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and couldn't gain late. MAN I LOVE CLARE saved ground and failed to menace. YOU BET WE WIN steadied in behind the leaders on the first turn, eased out and chased the pace three wide around the far turn, then faltered. VICTORY SNIT was through early. PANAMA MON was no factor when she broke down and fell in deep stretch.
