**Footnotes**

UPGRADE vied for the lead outside OLYMPIC DANZ, drew clear from that rival around the far turn and into the stretch, then was all out to last for a dead heat with HAILSTONE. The latter, rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn, then rallied to finish on terms with UPGRADE. LET'S DO IT reserved off the pace after breaking slowly, steadied when trapped in behind a wall of horses on the far turn, angled in for room and rallied along the rail for the show. VERSAILLES ROAD unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and closed well to just miss the show. MIDDLE OF THE NITE off slowly, stalked the pace three wide into the stretch and gave way. DANEHILL SUNSET (IRE) outrun after breaking slowly, gained some ground without threatening. DOUBLE EAGLE (ARG) steadied from between rivals in the early going, tracked the leaders to nearing the stretch, then tired. BLAZEN was no factor after breaking in the air. OLYMPIC DANZ (BRZ) vied for the lead along the rail to the far turn, then faded.
