ST. JOE broke a step slowly, chased the leaders three wide into the stretch, then rallied to be up late. WRITTEN IN STONE reserved off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and rallied to be up for the place. GARY D bumped with TOBES THE MAN at the start, chased the pace into the stretch and continued on with good courage while being outfinished by the top ones. TOBES THE MAN bumped between rivals at the start, showed speed along the rail to deep stretch and weakened. BERGERAC well placed while saving ground, eased out in the stretch and closed with a mild response. OUR CHAMPION steadied when he bumped with TOBES THE MAN at the start, saved ground around the turn and found his best stride late. SAYIF (IRE) failed to menace after being checked at the start.
