Footnotes

DEEP DIVE stalked the pace while saving ground, angled three wide on the far turn, rallied to gain the lead inside the eighth pole and just lasted over HURRAHY. The latter, reserved early, swung out four wide for the stretch run and rallied to just miss. PAVILLON (BRZ) stalked the pace three wide, took over command on the far turn but had nothing left for the final eighth. SHARP APPEAL set the pace along the rail and tired. THE KAISER, unhurried early, lacked a rally. WARRANT failed to menace. DANIELLE'S GRAY was outrun. BULLET VALAY, broke awkwardly, prompted the pace for a half mile and stopped.
