Footnotes

KITTEN'S JOY moved out a bit along the backstretch, raced in good position for six furlongs, saved ground through the turn, angled out approaching the stretch then unleashed a strong late run to win going away. PRINCE ARCH was unhurried for six furlongs, gained three wide on the turn, angled seven wide entering the stretch and finished strongly to best the others. PA PA DA lodged a bid three wide on the turn, surged to the front in midstretch then yielded in the final seventy yards. MASTER WILLIAM raced far back to the turn, advanced along the inside entering the stretch and rallied belatedly between horses. COMMENDATION raced between horses on the turn, swung seven wide in upper stretch then closed late from outside. MUSTANFAR raced evenly while five wide on the turn then rallied mildly. PINCAY raced well back to the turn and rallied belatedly. SOVERIGN HONOR steadied while being pinched back at the start and failed to threaten thereafter. GIN RUMMY CHAMP forced the pace from outside into upper stretch and tired. AMERICA AMERICA failed to threaten while saving ground. GOLD SHIELD was used up setting the early pace. WEST VIRGINIA chased in the two path for six furlongs and faded.
