Footnotes

ADMIRALITY rated off the pace about the four path on the backstretch, saved ground making his bid into the turn, got through on the rail entering the stretch and dug in with sheer determination to stave off the equally game Diomedes. DIOMEDES rated close three wide on the backstretch, took a short brief lead toward the quarter pole, dueled gamely taking the lead intermittently in the stretch then ultimately outfinished just under the wire. DREAM MAESTRO rated off the pace about the four path, drew to close contention near the five sixteenths pole then gradually yielded the stretch. YOU AND I FOREVER, very sluggish at the break, advanced toward contention inside, eased three wide into the turn, angled to the outside in midstretch and finished evenly. GET THE NEWS gave chase toward the inside and had no stretch response. ANEWDAY rated a short lead inside, contested the rail on the turn then faded through the lane. UNIQUE AFLEET rated close to the early pace two deep and between horses but gave way toward the turn. TRACK MAYOR and KEY CLASSIC were outrun
