Footnotes

MANITOWISH WATERS chased the pace, rallied to take over at the quarter pole, then was all out to prevail. CLANDESTINE FURY reserved racing along the rail, steadied from close quarters on the first turn, was still saving ground when checked waiting for room in behind EXCESS CAPITAL on the far turn, came around rivals and angled back to the rail, then was gaining on the winner at the finish. UNACCOUNTABLE stalked the pace three wide into the stretch but didn't do enough late. EXCESS CAPITAL stalked the pace along the inside, eased out for room in the stretch and finished willingly. ROMAN SILVER failed to menace. DUKINFIELD stalked the pace four wide into the stretch and gave way. ALTONA ROAD stumbled at the start, then steadied in behind rivals soon after entering the first turn and failed to menace. COBY was not a factor. VICTOR'S STRIKE showed some early foot and tired. IMPERIAL GLITTER lunged at the start, then was taken up in behind rivals on the first turn and outrun. CASIMIRO set the pace along the rail to nearing the stretch, then faded when he bled and was pulled up.
