GALAMINE, off slowly, raced four wide around the first turn, rallied to take over command approaching the eighth pole and drew away under pressure. JAMERICA with the pace three wide, drew clear and moved to the rail on the far turn but was no match for the winner while continuing on well for the place. DANCE FOR PLEASURE, unhurried early, raced four wide on the far turn, rallied through the stretch and just missed the place. CHIBI advanced into contention on the far turn, then weakened. MARATAYA'S DANCER chased the pace and tired. TRY N PASS, bumped at the start, failed to menace. PEACE N QUIET vied for the lead into the far turn and gave way. SHE'S A BLOCKER was outrun after bumping with TRY N PASS at the start. WINTUCKET showed brief speed along the rail and stopped. DIVINE LIZ was outrun.
