Footnotes

PRETTY POSSIBLE tracked the pace, angled three wide on the far turn, rallied to take over in early stretch and drew clear. VERKHOTINA (GB) rated off the pace, steadied in traffic on the backstretch, then closed to be up for the place while unable to match strides with the winner. LADY HARTWOOD allowed to settle after breaking slowly, swung out for the stretch run and closed with a belated rally to just miss the place. PIPERS HONOUR reserved in striking position off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and had no response when asked. IS THIS GOOD chased the leaders into the stretch and gave way.

APT TO BANK chased the pace, moved to gain a slim lead on the far turn, made the pace into the stretch and tired. GOLD STAR EVENT unhurried early, swung wide for the stretch run and never threatened. SOUL STAR set the pace along the rail into the far turn and faltered. EL BELAJO was never a factor. SHE CAN PUNCH was outrun. LAVA LAMP showed little. OPEN YOUR MOUTH chased the leaders along the inside into the far turn and faded.
