ACT FOOLISH vied for the lead along the rail, edged away leaving the far turn, then was all out to prevail. IOWA'S IMAGE unhurried early, raced four wide on the far turn and rallied to be up for the place. DANCIN GIRL rated off the pace, advanced four wide around the far turn to reach the attending position in the stretch but couldn't gain ground late and was just edged for the place. LICENSE TO SPEED tracked the pace along the inside into the stretch and closed with a mild rally to just miss the place and show. PIANO CHIMES reserved early, saved ground and lacked a late response. DANIA BAY chased the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and tired. RINGAROUNDAROSIE failed to menace. PLEDGE OF PEACE allowed to settle, was saving ground when steadied leaving the far turn and was not a factor. JOSIE'SLIL'ACTRESS off slowly, was always outrun. EXCELLENT IDEA vied for the lead outside ACT FOOLISH to nearing the stretch and faltered.
