APPEALING RUNNER tracked the pace, angled four wide on the turn, then rallied along the outside to be up late. SWING LANE showed speed off the rail to deep stretch and just failed to last. TILT MY HORNS showed brief speed along the rail, chased the leaders into the stretch after being outmoted on the turn, then continued on gamely for the show while being edged to the wire by the top ones. CRANBERRY ISLES unhurried after bobbling at the start, passed tired rivals. BILLS GLORY showed brief speed from the outside, chased the pace three wide around the turn and tired. MAX'S SONG raced three wide and never threatened. TIME TO INDULGE was no factor while racing four wide. YO JOAN off slowly, tracked the pace three wide around the turn and faltered. WP TOUR hit the gate at the start, then steadied in behind rivals on the backstretch and faded.
