Footnotes

FATE TAKES A HAND bumped with HERB ENGAGEMENT at the start, chased the pace, rallied to take over at the top of the stretch, then drew off under pressure. TEXAS BILLY BOY reserved off the pace, saved ground into the stretch, eased out and closed to be up for the place while no match for the winner. SCOTTISH DIAMOND bumped with HERB ENGAGEMENT at the start, set the pace along the inside to the top of the stretch, then gave way. UNGI BLANC allowed to settle, improved his position without threatening. BEAMING up close after bumping with SIX PACK ABS in the early going, checked along the inside nearing the end of the backstretch, saved ground around the turn and tired. SIX PACK ABS bumped with BEAMING in the early going, chased the pace into the turn and faltered. HERB ENGAGEMENT was no factor after being squeezed back at the start. MAJESTY'S MISSILE chased the leaders three wide around the turn and faded. EVIL EMPIRE was through after a half mile. LABROT off slowly, was outrun. EYE AND A HALF was done early and eased in the final eighth.
