SMART FARMING reserved racing along the inside, advanced into contention around the far turn, eased out and rallied to catch GRACE'N STYLE inside the eighth pole, then edged away from that rival late. GRACE'N STYLE stalked the pace, rallied to take over on the far turn, responded when challenged by SMART FARMING inside the eighth pole but couldn't stay with that rival late. TOXIC ASSET rated off the pace, advanced to loom a threat in midstretch but couldn't sustain her bid. THE GARDENER unhurried early, rallied to reach contention in the stretch, then flattened out and finished on even terms with TIGER ON THE GREEN. The latter, allowed to settle after hitting the gate hard at the start, swung out for the stretch run and closed with a mild response to dead heat with THE GARDENER. LEONESSA outrun after breaking poorly, advanced into the stretch while angling to the inside but had no late response. DUCHESS OF DOOM stalked the pace four wide to nearing the stretch, then tired. MANDATED TO WIN was not a factor. SILVER MINTED stalked the pace to nearing the stretch and faltered. ROYAL BERN set the pace along the rail into the far turn, then had nothing left. SHAHADAROBA chased the pace three wide to the top of the stretch, then faded.
