XUNLEI pressed the pace three wide, moved to take over at the top of the stretch, then drew away under urging. BLUE DISTINCTION set the pace under pressure racing off the rail to the top of the stretch, then couldn't match strides with the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. POLISH TUNE chased the pace into the stretch and gave way. FRENCH POLITICS off slowly, saved ground around the turn, then tired. HIGHLAND SARA saved ground and faltered. ROYAL PROMISE broke slowly, tracked the pace off the rail into the stretch, then faded. MY SIERRA NEVADA checked in the early going, raced four wide around the turn and dropped back. ADELA'S SONG was through after a half mile. OBRIGETA chased the pace into the turn, then bled and was eased in the stretch run.
