KINGOFALLDIAMONDS stalked the pace, eased out and rallied to take over in deep stretch, then just lasted over FOREVER THING. The latter, allowed to settle after breaking slowly, raced four wide around the far turn, then rallied to just miss. PARNELLI vied for the lead outside SURFSPUN around the first turn, eased to the inside after clearing that rival on the backstretch, responded when challenged by FORCE MULTIPLIER around the far turn, maintained a slim advantage to deep stretch and yielded. BAD HOMBRE tracked the leaders three wide into the stretch, then finished willingly to just miss the show.

FORCE MULTIPLIER chased the pace, made a run to try PARNELLI around the far turn and through the stretch, then weakened late. MARKET OUTLOOK rated off the pace, closed ground late without threatening. TIZ NOW MY CHOICE unhurried early, angled out for the stretch run, then closed with a belated rally. IT'S A BAD RAPIT raced three wide and failed to menace. SUMMER SHINER was not a factor. HARRYTHENAVIGATOR steadied soon after entering the first turn, then saved ground to no avail. SURFSPUN vied for the early lead along the inside, then steadied on the far turn and faltered. SEVENOAKS trailed.
