Footnotes

VERY PLAYFUL allowed to settle, angled out leaving the far turn, then rallied to be just up at the wire. CONQUESTA drifted out racing into the first turn, was angled back in while sprinting to a clear lead, made the pace along the inside into the stretch, then just failed to last. SLAMMIN ROSE unhurried after bumping soundly with GENERATIONS Y soon after the start, was saving ground when steadied soon after entering the far turn, recovered and finished willingly to gain the show. WITCH WAY NORTH carried wide by CONQUESTA racing into the first turn, chased that rival off the rail into the stretch, then weakened. STARSHIP SULTRY reserved in striking position off the pace, saved ground into the stretch, then gave way. ENGLISH CROSSING rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and tired. GENERATIONS Y steadied at the start, then bumped hard with SLAMMIN ROSE soon after and was outrun.
