MR. JOHN chased HANA HIGHWAY into the stretch and rallied under pressure to be up late. HANA HIGHWAY sprinted to a clear lead along the inside and continued on with good courage to prove second best while unable to stay with the winner late. SPEIGHTSTOWN drifted to the inside in the early going, raced well placed into the stretch and lacked a rally. ASSASSINATOR unhurried early, passed tired rivals. CELADON steadied in behind SPEIGHTSTOWN early, raced three wide around the turn and tired. FAST LINE was outrun. AMJAAD steadied when caught at the start, raced four wide on the turn and was not a factor. SAINTLY SCENE was checked along the inside when SPEIGHTSTOWN drifted in racing down the backstretch, then faded leaving the turn.
