Footnotes

SANGRITA pressed the pace, moved to gain command midway of the turn, then drew off while being ridden out. HI LILI set the pace along the inside to midway of the turn, then was no match for the winner while holding the place. GRAND RIDGE chased the leaders off the rail around the turn, then couldn't keep pace with the top one while gaining the show. STARS INDY SKIES reserved early, passed tired rivals without threatening. DIVA raced three wide and tired. ELECTRIC SKY was steadied when she ducked in at the start, moved up to chase the pace along the rail around the turn and faltered. ELUSIVE FAITH was not a factor. ELLIOT'S EXCHANGE showed early foot, raced three wide on the turn and faded. ARCHSTONE was outrun. WEST SIDE DANCER off slowly, raced four wide on the turn and had nothing left for the drive. QUIET HEROINE showed little and was eased in the stretch run.
