ROUND TRIP LONER pressed the pace outside BULL DOZER while in hand, took over from that rival nearing the quarter pole, then drew clear under urging. GO RICHIE GO chased the pace along the inside to midway of the turn, angled three wide for racing room and closed to prove best of the rest while unable to get to the winner. DREAM OF SIDNEY chased the pace off the rail into the stretch but couldn't keep pace with the top ones while gaining the show. ASYLUM failed to menace. FLYING APPROVAL never threatened after being steadied when knocked into CHIEF THUNDERCLOUD at the start. CHIEF THUNDERCLOUD was no factor after being bumped and steadied at the start. THE A. TRAIN chased the pace three wide around the turn and tired. BULL DOZER bumped with FLYING APPROVAL at the start, set the pace under pressure along the rail to past midway of the turn, then faltered. SLICK VIC chased the pace four wide around the turn and faded.
