RED JAG chased the pace three wide, rallied to take over nearing the eighth pole, then edged away. SPICY SALSA unhurried early, saved ground into the stretch, angled out for room and rallied for the place. VALTER rated off the pace, advanced to loom a threat in midstretch but couldn't sustain his bid. SUSTAINABLE FOREST vied for the lead outside CLASSIC BROOK into the stretch, then gave way. MINE N GEMS reserved off the pace, raced four wide around the turn and had no response when asked. VERVEITUP failed to menace. CLASSIC BROOK vied for the lead along the rail into the stretch, then tired. MY PEOPLE tracked the pace three wide around the turn and faltered. BIG BENTLEY was not a factor.
