DIVINE PRAYER pressed the pace outside TRICKANOMETRY, drew clear from that rival approaching the quarter pole, then increased his margin through the stretch under urging. WHATS NEXT MON chased the pace three wide around the turn and closed to be up for the place while no match for the winner. TRICKANOMETRY set the pace under pressure along the rail into the turn, then tired. SUNSATONAL well placed while saving ground, lacked a rally. EL ROLLO failed to menace. DOC TOUR off slowly, raced three wide and faltered. AARONS SPECIAL was outrun after breaking slowly. STEPHAN showed little. MR. CHOCOLATTE chased the pace into the turn and faded.
