WESLEY rated off the pace, angled outside the leaders for the stretch run, rallied to take over inside the eighth pole, then drew clear. WHEELS UP AT NOON off slowly, stalked the pace three wide into the stretch, then closed to be up for the place while being outfinished by the winner. NOWNOWNOW reserved early, angled out and made a run to loom a threat in the stretch but couldn't sustain his bid. MARQUET CAT set the pace along the rail to past the eighth pole, then tired. DANAK (IRE) chased the pace, made a run to reach near even terms for command in the stretch, then faltered. GRAND CASH was outrun.
