SOARING EMPIRE unhurried after bumping with OCTAVO at the start, angled wide leaving the turn, then rallied to be up late. ALLEZ REEF chased the pace four wide around the turn, then rallied to be up for the place while being outfinished by the winner. HAVANADAYDREAM vied for the lead between horses, edged clear in the stretch, then gave way late. OCTAVO bumped with SOARING EMPIRE at the start, tracked the pace along the inside into the stretch, then weakened. AFLEET EXPRESS off slowly, tracked the pace three wide around the turn and tired. KRATISTO was no factor after being outrun early. ROMAN HALL vied for the lead along the rail to nearing the stretch, then faltered. LATIGO SHORE vied for the lead three wide, then was steadied from between rivals at the top of the stretch and faded. SKY VENTURE was not a factor. BRICKLAYER was done early.
