**Footnotes**

BIG JEROME rated off the pace, angled out for the stretch run, then rallied under pressure to be up in the final strides. POINTING NORTH (SAF) chased the pace, moved to gain a slim lead leaving the far turn, then dueled with DUG IN through the stretch and held that rival off for the place while unable to resist the winner. DUG IN allowed to settle, rallied four wide around the far turn to engage POINTING NORTH nearing the eighth pole, then dueled with that rival and was edged to the wire by the top ones. I'VE GOT SPEED unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and closed with a mild rally. QUIET EMARATI reserved racing along the rail, advanced around the far turn to reach contention but had no late response. GULF RUCKUS up close early, dropped back around the far turn and never threatened thereafter. COACH GRAVY set the pace along the rail to nearing the stretch, then tired in the final eighth. CINNAMON ROAD stalked the pace three wide to midway of the far turn, then faltered. FABULOUS FRONTIER trailed.
