ALOTABULL showed speed along the inside and drew off under pressure. MILWAUKEE BREW chased the pace three wide into the stretch and proved second best. REMEMBERED well placed while saving ground, was best of the rest. RIVER BED failed to menace. CHARLES BRIDGE hopped at the start, chased the pace around the turn and tired. TICKET TO FREEDOM was outrun while racing four wide around the turn. WITH CHARM was never close. SAINT REDDIE showed little. FOOLISH HALO trailed after breaking slowly and bled.
