Footnotes

FILM MAKER tracked the pace three wide, rallied to take over at the top of the stretch and drew clear under urging. BOOM BAH YAY very rank under restraint early, bumped soundly with ARMOURETTE and checked early, continued to be very rank while checking a couple of times on the first turn, raced in good position along the rail into the stretch, checked when blocked in behind TEAK TOTEM in midstretch, angled inside that rival and finished willingly for the place. WEAR unhurried after being steadied when caught in tight outside BOOM BAH YAY on the first turn, angled to the outside on the far turn while rallying to loom a threat in the stretch but didn't do enough late. TEAK TOTEM vied for the lead along the inside to the top of the stretch, then weakened. ARMOURETTE was bumped soundly by BOOM BAH YAY in the early going, checked and failed to menace. TOTEBOOK unhurried early, swung to the outside for the stretch run and failed to threaten. FASHION SENSE rated off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and tired. OPTIMIZE vied for the lead outside TEAK TOTEM to the top of the stretch and faltered. MARICOT was outrun. K. O. BRIDE showed early foot, faded and was eased in the final eighth.
