ERDA reserved early, angled four wide on the far turn, rallied to take over in early stretch and drew clear. MYSTERIEUSE ETOILE unhurried early, angled out for the stretch run and rallied to prove second best. MISS SANATA showed speed off the rail, vied for the lead outside JOVIALNESS down the backstretch and around the far turn, then tired in the drive. JOVIALNESS steadied leaving the first turn, advanced along the rail to reach MISS SANATA on the backstretch, vied for the lead along the rail into the stretch, then faltered after his rider lost his whip in early stretch. WINNER TAKES ALL chased the pace three wide, made a run at the leaders on the far turn, then faded in the drive. TWINKLE AND SHINE was through after a half mile.
