Footnotes

PINT THIEF was well placed for six furlongs, angled three wide while rallying on the turn, surged to the front in upper stretch, battled into deep stretch then was fully extended to hold off the runner-up in the final strides. VOODOO FEVER raced in the middle of the pack along the inside, rallied along the rail midway on the turn, awaited rook while in traffic nearing the quarter pole, swung out in upper stretch then finished fastest but could not get up. EXTRAVAGANT GAL sprinted clear in the early stages, set the pace under pressure to the far turn, battled into upper stretch and weakened from her early efforts. PIRATE'S BOOTY trailed after being pinched back at the start, rallied along the rail leaving the turn, steadied in traffic in upper stretch then closed late along the inside. LATIN LUST checked after being pinched at the start, was unhurried for six furlongs, swung six wide leaving the quarter pole then rallied mildly. JEWELL DARE bobbled at the start, was outrun early, gained in traffic on the turn, angled five wide at the quarter pole and lacked a strong late response. MOYNE ABBEY rushed up from outside, pressed the pace for six furlongs and steadily tired thereafter. SILVER SONIC was never a factor. MANHANDLER chased four wide to the top of the stretch and gave way.
