UNION RAGS never far back while in hand early, moved to gain command three wide on the far turn while still in hand, then drew away through the stretch under a hand ride. NEWS PENDING pressed the pace off the rail into the far turn, then was no match for the winner while continuing on with good courage to prove best of the rest. DISCREET DANCER set the pace under pressure along the inside to midway of the far turn, then gave way. NECK 'N NECK bumped with FORT LOUDON at the start, then steadied on the first turn, raced in striking position off the pace into the far turn, then tired. FORT LOUDON bumped and steadied from between rivals at the start, was through after six furlongs. CSABA was no factor after stumbling badly at the start. CASUAL TRICK bumped with FORT LOUDON at the start, stalked the pace to nearing the stretch, then faded.
