Footnotes

STARSHIP STORM reserved early, rallied along the rail to take over nearing the sixteenth pole and edged away. LE GRAND ARTISTE unhurried early, angled out for the stretch run and rallied to be up for the place. RUTHLESS EMPIRE outrun early, angled to the outside for the stretch run and rallied to just miss the place. SLINGER rated off the pace while saving ground, angled out leaving the far turn, rallied to reach the attending position at the eighth pole but was outfinished. YES HE'S TROUBLE stalked the pace into the stretch and closed with a mild response. RANGEY chased the pace along the inside,

moved to take over on the far turn, made the pace into the stretch and weakened. PIKESTAR allowed to settle, gained some ground without threatening. MALIBU WAVE failed to menace. HERTZEL was not a factor. FLANAGAN STATION set the pace off the rail into the far turn and tired. HONOR'S GOLD stalked the pace three wide, then faltered in the drive. DIGGIN UP A RUCKUS forced wide on the first turn, was through after a half mile.
