LEMON DROP KID, well placed while reserved in behind the ALANNAN, moved outside that rival on the far turn to reach even terms for command, then drew away through the stretch under urging while jumping over the gate tracks and switching leads approaching the sixteenth pole. CRYPTODIPLOMACY stalked the pace three wide and gained the place while no match for the winner. ALANNAN set the pace racing off the rail and tired in the drive. MINERS GAMBLE, outrun early, was no threat while four wide around the far turn. BAYONET was away slowly when he lunged at the start, saved ground into the stretch and faltered. BADGER GOLD well placed early, faded.
