MIZAJ set the pace along the inside and proved best under pressure. MUNAZA, reserved off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and rallied to be up for the place. GUN FIGHT, unhurried early, raced four wide on the far turn and improved his position. MILWAUKEE JOHN chased the pace, advanced into the attending position on the far turn, then weakened. CLOSER TOTHE HEART advanced into contention on the far turn and tired. REDHANDED was no threat after being outrun early. DANCE N' JAC hit the gate at the start and was through early. FARMA was taken back when he bore out on the first turn, then was not a factor. CREDIT APPROVED stalked the pace for a half mile and gave way. QUIESCENT was through after a half mile.
