**Footnotes**

ICANSEECLEARLY tracked the pace, was steadied in behind the leaders on the far turn, then rallied outside FOLLIES DANCER to take over nearing the eighth pole and drew clear under pressure. MINER'S CROWN well placed while saving ground, angled out for the stretch run and closed to be up for the place. FOLLIES DANCER outrun for the lead around the first turn, rallied off the rail to take over again on the far turn, made the pace into the stretch and weakened. TECHNICAL QUESTION unhurried early, raced three wide on the far turn and passed tired rivals. KELLY DOT COM showed speed outside FOLLIES DANCER, moved clear of that rival racing down the backstretch, angled to the inside on the far turn and tired in the drive. KNIGHT MISTRESS was not a factor. VICTORIAN SILVER tracked the pace three wide to nearing the stretch and faltered.
