Footnotes

BIRTHDAY SONG sprinted clear in the early stages, set the pace along the rail, dug in after losing the lead in midstretch and battled back gamely to prevail after a long drive. CLASSIC EXAMPLE settled in the middle of the pack, rallied three wide on the turn, gained a slim lead in upper stretch then yielded late. GROOMEROMA raced in the middle of the pack for a half, angled five wide rallying into the stretch and finished evenly. GENTILLE ALOUETTE broke slowly, raced well back for five furlongs, circled seven wide into the stretch and passed only tiring horses. CATZINGA raced up close along the rail to the turn and faded. LAURAEELISES SISTER up close early, gave way while six wide on the turn. RUNAWAY KITTEN broke slow, steadied along the rail on the far turn and was never close thereafter.
