ROMAN TIGER rated off the pace after checked on the first turn, saved ground around the far turn, then rallied for the show. WAR HOOT unhurried after being bothered on the first turn, swung out for the stretch run and closed with a belated rally. SPECTACULAR KID set the pace along the rail to nearing the eighth pole, then gave way. HARIOLUS (BRZ) outrun early, improved his position in the drive. KEEP THINKING bumped with QUE DESEO in the early going, moved up on the backstretch to track the leaders four wide around the far turn, then tired. STAGE DELI saved ground to no avail. MANCHILD chased the pace three wide, then steadied in close quarters in the stretch and faltered. QUE DESEO bumped with KEEP THINKING in the early going and was not a factor. THOTH raced three wide and faded.
