The latter, chased the pace three wide into the stretch and finished willingly for the place while unable to get to the winner. IT'S SATURDAY NITE set the pace under pressure along the rail into the stretch and gave way. HEAVEN KNOWS WHAT chased the leaders three wide into the stretch, then tired. MYTHICAL BRIDE raced three wide and faltered. JIM'S LONESA reserved off pace, faded. WILL TO SHINE was outrun after breaking awkwardly.
