Footnotes

LEVERAGED LOAN chased the pace three wide, moved up to engage PONTUS leaving the far turn, then dueled with that rival to deep stretch and prevailed. PONTUS set the pace along the inside, responded when challenged by LEVERAGED LOAN racing into the stretch, then dueled with that rival to deep stretch but was outgamed to the wire. SPIVEY chased the pace off the rail into the stretch, then gave way. GOLD MATE failed to menace while racing three wide. BACKSEAT MEMORIES rated off the pace, tired. POCO MAN was outrun. MAKE OUT MAN very rank early, chased the pace along the inside for a half mile, then faded and was eased in the stretch run.
