Footnotes

PERSONAL TOUCH outrun early, saved ground around the turn, angled wide for the stretch run and closed fast to be up late. PRETTY WILD with the pace racing along the rail, moved through to take over on the turn, opened a clear lead in the stretch but couldn't hold off the winner in the final strides. ANY WAY AT ALL well placed racing off the rail, couldn't keep pace with the top ones in the drive while gaining the show. MOMBO LOCO unhurried early, saved ground and passed tired rivals. SKIER'S GIFT chased the leaders four wide around the turn and tired. OMINOUS reserved early, advanced into contention off the rail, then faltered in the drive. PARHELION (GER) vied for the lead three wide, then gave way in the drive. SKYCROSSING was not a factor. RED VINTAGE (GB) showed little. GET SMARTER raced four wide on the turn and faded. WERBLIN vied for the lead between horses to nearing the stretch and stopped.
