Footnotes

WILLY O'THE VALLEY settled just off the early pace, made a strong four wide move to gain a slim lead at the quarter pole, extended his advantage in midstretch and was all out to hold off UNIGOLD in the final strides. UNIGOLD was reserved for a half, launched a rally four wide on the turn then closed steadily but could not get up. NIGHTMARE AFFAIR raced well back for six furlongs, circled five wide into the stretch and rallied belatedly. EUROSILVER broke inward and bumped with ROYAL ASSAULT at the start, settled in the middle of the pack, rallied between horses to reach contention leaving the turn and lacked a strong closing bid. PEGASO (PER) broke down after the finish. STRIVE broke outward and bumped with ROYAL ASSAULT at the start, never reached contention. BADA BAM BADA BOOM raced wide and tired. GRANITE HEAD set the pace along the rail and gave way. ROYAL ASSAULT was bumped hard from both sides and failed to menace while racing wide.
