SILK TRIPPI pressed the pace outside TRAVOLTA, took over from that rival on the turn, then drew off through the stretch while being kept to pressure. COMPRISE rated off the pace, raced four wide around the turn and closed to prove best of the rest. JIM N ALICE'S HOPE showed early foot, eased back around the turn, then passed tired rivals to be up for the show. VEER chased the pace into the stretch and tired. TRAVOLTA set the pace under pressure along the inside to nearing the quarter pole, then faltered. SNEAKY STEPHEN was not a factor. TAMAZUNCHALE was outrun after being steadied when bumped by CAYMUS CAPOTE. The latter, bobbled and bumped TAMAZUNCHALE at the start, chased the pace three wide around the turn and faded.
