**Footnotes**

AFFIRMATIF set the pace off the rail, responded when headed by CARDIOLOGIST on the backstretch, quickly regained the advantage, made the pace into the far turn, then drew off while being kept to pressure. LAUREATE CONDUCTOR reserved off the pace, advanced along the inside into the stretch and closed to prove best of the rest while no threat to the winner. SEEKING THE SLUICE tracked the leaders into the far turn, then couldn't keep pace with the top ones while up for the show. SPARTAN KING rated off the pace, advanced along the rail to reach the attending position in the stretch, then tired. OREE saved ground into the far turn, swung out and improved his position. INDY'S SPELL failed to menace. VIRSITO saved ground and faltered. INDIAN FOG chased the pace three wide to nearing the stretch, then had nothing left. MISTY OAK was outrun after breaking poorly. FINAL COUNT showed little. THOR'S PIPER showed brief speed and stopped. CARDIOLOGIST rushed up four wide to gain a brief lead on the backstretch, then couldn't stay with the winner and faded leaving the far turn.
