TWILIGHT METEOR stalked the pace, made a run to engage BUDDY'S HUMOR approaching the quarter pole, dueled with that rival to deep stretch and edged away. BUDDY'S HUMOR quickly moved to the fore, made the pace along the rail, responded when challenged by TWILIGHT METEOR on the far turn, then dueled with that rival to deep stretch and gave way grudgingly. BUFFALO MAN stalked the pace along the rail, eased out for the stretch run and finished willingly to just miss the place. VANQUISHER taken in hand, was steadied soon after entering the first turn, swung out for the stretch run and was gaining at the finish. PASSAGER (FR) rated off the pace, made a run three wide on the far turn to reach contention, then weakened in the drive. ROGUE VICTORY unhurried early, swung wide for the stretch run and closed with a belated rally. JUST AS WELL allowed to settle, raced three wide and had no response when asked. BUJAGALI chased the pacesetter into the far turn and tired. SPORTING ART well placed while saving ground into the stretch, lacked a rally. DELIGHTFUL KISS was not a factor. HEY BYRN steadied along the rail entering the first turn, faded on the far turn and was eased in the final eighth.
