Footnotes

OLYMPIST stalked the pace off the rail, rallied to take over entering the stretch, then drew off when asked. VALERIUS rated off the pace after being caught in tight at the start, saved ground around the turn and closed to be just up for the place while unable to stay with the winner. STAR PLAYER showed speed along the inside to the top of the stretch, then was no match for the winner while just failing to hold the place. FLYIN TREY showed speed three wide to midway of the turn, then tired. JARANERO up close early, faltered. ANDYSUN stumbled at the start, raced four wide and faded. ZUBER was done early. LEFT WING WACKO off slowly, was through after a half mile.
