TIME FOR A CURE well placed while saving ground, angled outside the leaders in the stretch and rallied to be up late. HIGH STEPPER vied for the lead along the rail and continued on gamely for the place while being outfinished. SARAI'S DANCER vied for the lead outside HIGH STEPPER and continued on with good courage while being edged for the place. I BE SHY reserved early, raced four wide on the far turn and lacked the needed late response. MAJESTIC MOOD unhurried early, raced four wide on the far turn, swung out even wider for the drive and failed to rally. SKY WING steadied in traffic on the backstretch, then was boxed in around the far turn and failed to threaten. D J K STORM saved ground while advancing into contention in the stretch but couldn't gain late. SLACKS was outrun. YOUR SONG chased the pace three wide into the stretch and tired. SWEET SCARLET showed early foot and faltered.
