Footnotes

DAYDREAMING bumped at the start, was bothered and forced out entering the first turn, advanced into contention three wide around the far turn, then rallied under pressure to be up late. SOUL OF THE CAT steadied from tight quarters racing into the first turn, rallied three wide on the far turn to reach even terms for command in the stretch, then was vying for the lead when she drifted out late impeding DANCE FEE and was outfinished. CHERRY BOMB was knocked into DAYDREAMING at the start, chased the pace, rallied to reach even terms for command at the top of the stretch, vied with SOUL OF THE CAT to deep stretch and weakened. DANCE FEE rated off the pace after being knocked into HOT MAIL entering the first turn, then was attempting to rally between horses when forced to check in behind SOUL OF THE CAT in deep stretch and failed to recover. ROUSED outrun early, raced three wide on the far turn and passed tired rivals. RUNAWAY RIZZI failed to menace. HOT MAIL bumped hard and forced out entering the first turn, raced four wide on the far turn and failed to be a factor. BARREL RACER saved ground while being outrun. DOUBLE LOCK bumped with CHERRY BOMB at the start, set the pace along the inside to the top of the stretch and tired. PURE ENERGY bumped with DANCE FEE entering the first turn, then steadied when in tight along the inside soon after, chased the pace into the far turn and faltered. WILD MISTRESS showed brief speed and faded. Following an objection by the rider of DANCE FEE against the rider of SOUL OF THE CAT for interference in deep stretch, SOUL OF THE CAT was disqualified and placed fourth.
