GREENERY set the pace along the rail into the stretch, then edged away under pressure. TREASURE CHEST stalked the pace three wide into the stretch but couldn't get to the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. BOBBIN stalked the pace along the inside into the stretch but had no late response and was edged for the place. QUEEN MOTHER reserved early, improved her position without threatening. CAMBRIDGE BELLE rated in striking position off the pace, lacked a rally. DEMURRER off slowly, failed to menace. ARTISTIC ESCAPE prompted the pace outside GREENERY into the far turn and tired. SENSE OF CLASS saved ground and faltered.
