POLITICAL COURAGE unhurried racing along the rail, rallied under a strong hand ride through the stretch to be up late. RUSTLER HUSTLER rated off the pace, rallied three wide around the far turn, moved to take over in the stretch but couldn't resist the winner late. LIVE IN JOY chased the pace, made a run to gain a slim lead leaving the far turn, made the pace into the stretch, then gave way. BROTHER PAT tracked the pace four wide around the far turn, then weakened. NIAM'S STRIKE set the pace along the rail to nearing the stretch, then tired. STRONG RESOLVE saved ground and failed to menace. FOOLISH TIGER was not a factor. STORM WARNINGS chased the pace into the far turn, then was fading when steadied in the stretch.
