Footnotes

GO JOE GO stalked the pace along the inside, eased outside HUGO LIGHT leaving the far turn, then rallied to be just up at the wire. HUGO LIGHT set the pace under pressure along the rail and just failed to last in a game effort. CALL FOR SILVER unhurried after being steadied along the rail in the early going, swung wide for the stretch run and closed well to be just up for the show. CHINGLISH outrun after being bumped between rivals at the start, raced four wide around the far turn, swung out for the stretch run and rallied while just being outfinished for the place. LACONIC tracked the pace, eased out and finished willingly. ROCK AMERICA stalked the pace three wide, made a run to reach near even terms for command at the eighth pole but was outfinished. RELAMPAGO allowed to settle after bumping with CHINGLISH at the start, raced three wide around the far turn, swung out for the stretch run and was gaining slowly between rivals. PUNSTER rated off the pace, was blocked in behind rivals around the far turn, then closed ground late without threatening. FRIENDS PLACE taken in hand early, angled out widest of all in the stretch and closed with a belated rally. ABSOLUTE POWER reserved racing along the rail, was advancing when forced to steady in behind HUGO LIGHT in the stretch and failed to recover. GUNS AND RELIGION bumped with CHINGLISH at the start, pressed the pace outside HUGO LIGHT into the stretch, then gave way. ROAD TO BABYLON was not a factor.
